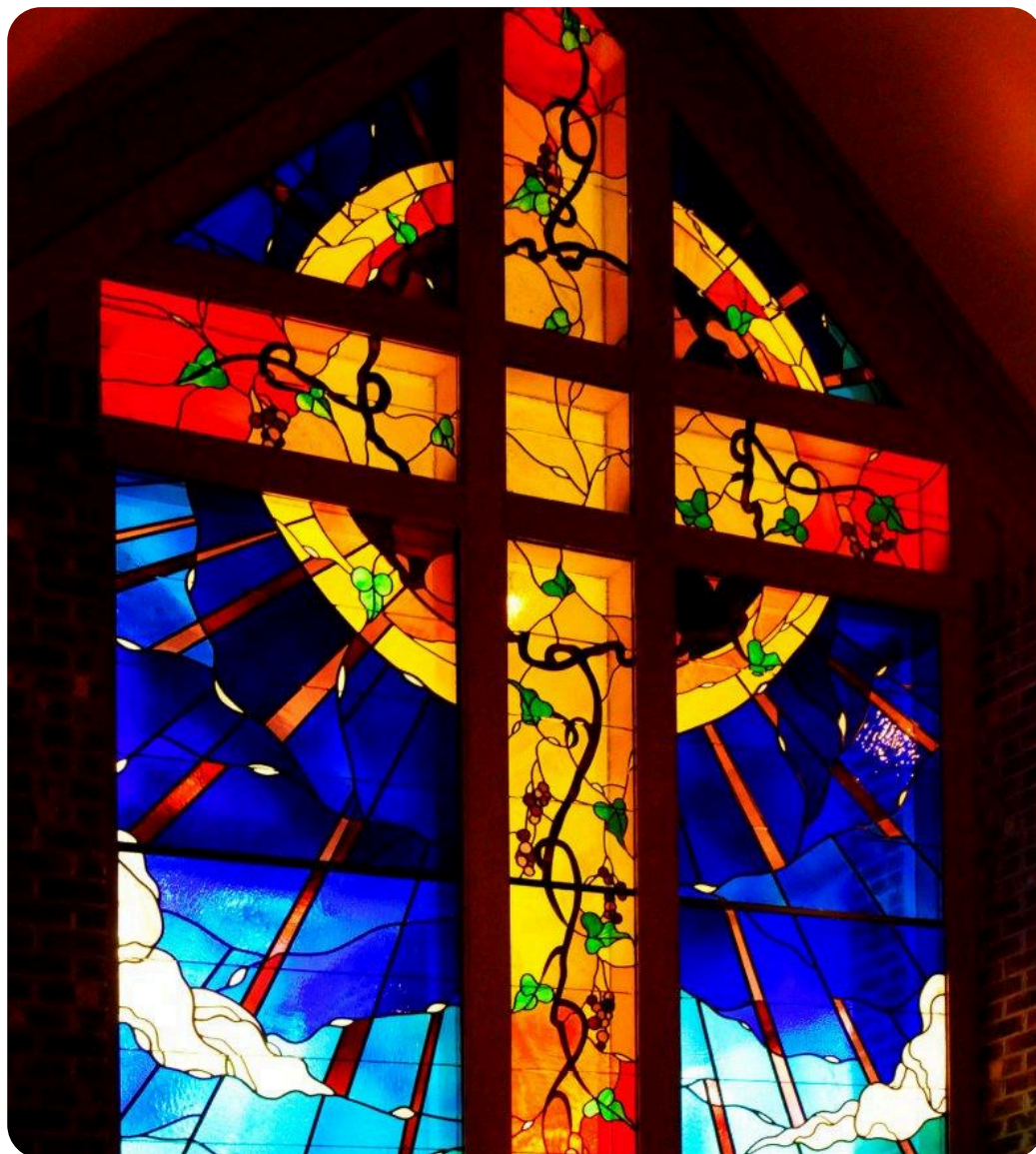

Lizzy Gunn, granddaughter of members Larry and Ann Gunn, graduated from high school and will attend the University of Michigan.



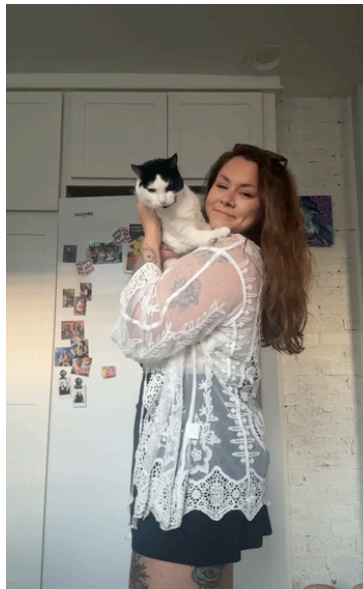
Isabel Husk, granddaughter of members Jeff and Sue Myers, is a high school graduate and plans to attend Coastal Carolina University with a major in Marine Science.

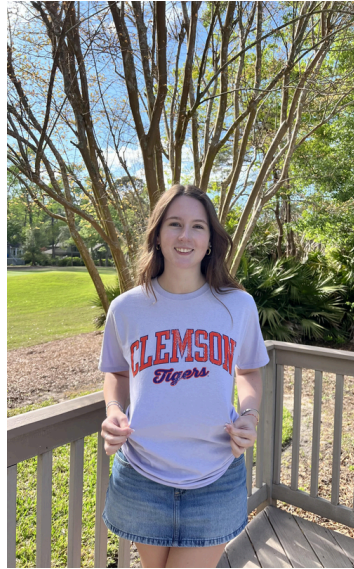
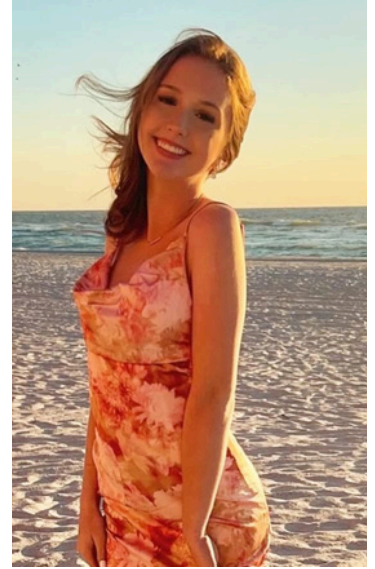
