

Douglas K. Fletcher Scholarship

The Douglas K. Fletcher Scholarship was created to fund supplies, equipment and textbooks needed by students to be successful in a college program. Applications are open to all students (regardless of immigration status) with the following qualifications:

Eligibility

- Applicants must reside in the service area of USCB or TCL, including Beaufort County.
- The scholarships will be for up to \$500 for books and supplies.
- “First in Family,” students attending college are eligible for the scholarships.
- Applicants must have at least 12 hours of college credit and have at least a 2.5 GPA.
- Applicant must be a full-time student at USCB or TCL (at least 12 hours/semester).
- **Applications are due by August 1 and January 1.**
- Applicants may re-apply for subsequent semesters.

Scholarship limit: \$500
