Habitat for Humanity		Build, through financial contributions and volunteer construction work, affordable housing at the Glen of Marshland Road.
Impact Mentoring		Work with Hilton Head Island elementary age students on a weekly basis.

Bahati Scholars - Kenya		Supports relationship and provides scholarship funding for homeless young people in the Nairobi Central Presbytery.
Haiti Mission Trip		Participate in mission team to support healthcare, construction and education in Haiti. Partnering with Haiti Outreach Ministries
Operation Christmas Child		Prepare boxes with basic hygiene and school supplies, as well as a toy for a child for Samaritan's Purse prior to Christmas season.

Deacon Ministries

Lay Visitation		Establish one on one long term relationships with people in need. Establish temporary relationships with people in transition.
Prayer Chain		Year round ministry of regular prayers for a list of people with medical and personal needs.
Prayer Project		Summer-only effort to connect all members of the congregation.. Pray for a group of members daily for three months.
Neighborhood Care Groups		Provide care and fellowship opportunities within geographic neighborhoods
Family Promise		Four weeks per year, FPC provides temporary shelter and transition to permanent housing solutions for families with children. Volunteers provide meals, serve a overnight hosts, etc.
Kairos Prison Ministry		Group of men volunteer one day/month and two weekends per year to spend time with the inmates at Savannah State and Allendale Prisons. This is a spiritual time designed to bring inmates to Christ.
Meals from the Heart		Cooks gather in the church kitchen several times a year to prepare chicken pot pies and soups that are later provided to members who may be facing surgery or a crisis in their lives and are in need of caring concern.
Community Baking Ministry		Bakers gather in church kitchen to bake cookies for KAIROS Prison Ministry and for community outreach efforts.
Memorial Reception		Large committee provides comfort to families by preparing a beautiful reception following memorial services.
Flower Ministry		Members arrange and deliver flowers from the church to members in the hospital or at home on Sundays,
Knitting/Prayer Shawl Ministry		Group meets on Tuesdays at 1:30 to knit/crochet prayer shawls & baby items to convey care and support in times of need or joy
Health Ministries -Caring Friends		Offer non-medical companionship/respite for caregivers. Each volunteer offers two hours per month.
Health Ministries -Professionals		Administer blood pressure checks and/or make phone calls to FPC members who are chronically ill or recently hospitalized.
