Sacrificial Service

- **People In Need (PIN):** Our PIN ministry has reopened on Tuesdays from 9 AM-noon—with appropriate safety precautions in place—to assist people in our community with utility bills, rent and food from our pantry.
- **Operation Christmas Child (OCC) is gearing up!** Thanks to FPC members, our OCC shoeboxes numbered 196 in 2019 and were sent to children around the world through Samaritan’s Purse. We’re gearing up for another banner year of collecting Ivory soap (Why? It floats!), washcloths, toothbrushes, jump ropes, yo-yos, pencil erasers, handheld pencil sharpeners and a small, fun item for children. These items are packaged in plastic shoebox containers, and we hope to fill 200 this year. Our Knitting Ministry supplies a handmade crocheted rabbit for each box! These shoeboxes let children know that Jesus loves them and that He helped make this happen. FPC’s Global Missions Committee allocates funds from your tithes and offerings to pay for the shipping. Look for the plastic bin (labeled Operation Christmas Child) outside the double doors to the church office weekdays from 10 AM-4 PM. We’ll use appropriate safety precautions when handling the items. - **Donate items to our food pantry, local food pantries and soup kitchens:** canned soup, tuna or chicken, Chef Boyardee, canned fruit, peanut butter, jelly, pasta, pasta sauce, cereal, breakfast bars, soap, shampoo, lotion and toothpaste. Bag your items and place them in the blue plastic bin outside the double doors to the church office weekdays from 10 AM-4 PM. We’ll use appropriate safety precautions before distributing them.
