Sacrificial Service

- **Thirteenth Annual School Assistance Drive from August 8-28:** A new school year will soon begin! At FPC that means the Thirteenth Annual School Assistance Drive (formerly the School Uniform Drive). This ministry financially supports the educational needs of students in Beaufort, Hampton and Jasper counties. The goal is to help instill in all students a sense of confidence and belonging by providing supplies, technology and more! When donating, please specify School Assistance Drive on your check or note.
- **Thank you for your response to our COVID-19 appeal** (in worship in June). We collected almost \$15,000!
